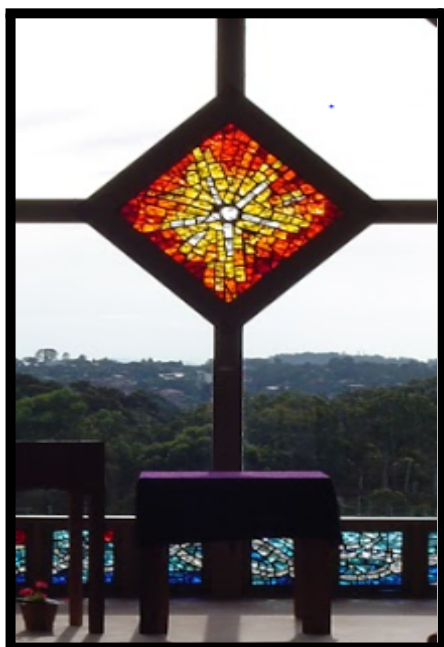

As a staff, we will look forward to receiving the NAPLAN data so that we can analyse longer-term trends as a source for informing school improvement.

PARENT-TEACHER INTERVIEWS - GUIDELINES

On Wednesday 2 April, the teachers will follow a process for the Parent Teacher Interviews to ensure we are consistent and meeting the purpose of the interviews. If there is a particular area you wish to focus on other than what is outlined below, we invite you to share this information with the teachers at the start of the interview. I hope that the interviews provide you with valuable feedback on your child's learning and social and emotional development.

Purpose;

- To provide clarity and feedback on learning.
- To provide feedback on how children are performing with work habits/behaviour/social relationships (Social Emotional Learning).
- To provide parents with a forum to discuss their child and how they learn and how they can support future learning goals

Structure of Parent-Teacher Interview;

- Teacher to provide feedback on current assessment and learning achievements.
- Teacher to discuss child's work habits, behaviour and social relationships (friendships)
- Parents invited to share anything that they feel would be relevant with the teacher to support their academic and/or social-emotional learning above and beyond previous discussions
