- Listen carefully and wait for your turn to speak without interrupting.
- Be respectful of the speaker.

We Play Safely and Move Safely

- Always be aware of your surroundings and the people around you.
- Be where you should be and keep your hands, feet and objects to yourself.
- Always walk around our school and follow directions.

We Report Behaviour When We Feel Unsafe

- Whenever you feel unsafe you tell that person how they are making you feel
- If it is a child you ask them to stop it.
- If it continues you report it to your teacher, the Deputy Principal or the Principal.
- If an adult makes you feel unsafe you report it to your parents, a, teacher, the Deputy Principal or the Principal.
